❖ Where is there parking available?



DO NOT PARK ALONG THE COURSE FOR SAFETY OF RUNNERS.

Please do not park along course route for the safety of our runners.

Parking within walking distance located at:


Heartland Early Childhood Center 1700 West Sheridan (.5 mi)

PARK AND RIDE OPTION

Busing will be provided from this lot ONLY.

Pick up starts at 6:45AM until 7:45 AM. Return rides back to parking lot run after race from 9:30AM-10:30AM.

❖ Is the course certified?

Yes, the 5K/10K course has been measured for accuracy, meets criteria for USATF distances, and is certified 5K-#KS15045KH. 10K -#KS15046KH This ensures that each participant can reliably compare his or her performance to those of other 5K/10K races and be eligible for potential records and rankings.

❖ When is the Bitty Bug Run?

The Bitty Bug Run take place approximately at 9:45. After the last race participant is through the 5K and 10K course. It will be a 100m dash to the finish line.

❖ Do I have to register for the Bitty Bug Run?

Yes, all participants must submit a completed entry form with signed waiver of liability. This can be done in advance on-line, at packet pickup, or on race day. All Bitty Bug Run participants will receive a cape. This event is for children 5 years old and younger.

❖ Can I still register on race day?

YES! You can still register at packet pickup before the race. Race day registration is \$35 for the 5K and \$45 for the 10K.

❖ **When and where is packet pickup?**

You may pick up your packet or sign up at Rolling Ridge Elementary (1500 W Elm Terr, Olathe, KS) on:
Friday, April 6th from 8 AM to 7 PM
Saturday, April 7th from 6 AM to 7:15 AM
T-shirts not guaranteed for late registrations.

❖ **I registered but can no longer participate. Can I pick up my race shirt or transfer my registration?**

Yes, you can certainly still pick up your race shirt. Alternatively, if you would like to transfer your registration, please contact us immediately at amyvrban@yahoo.com. We will do our best to accommodate your request but cannot guarantee it.

❖ **What if there is inclement weather?**

The race will go on as scheduled, rain or shine. Dress appropriately. If lightning is in the area, the race will be called for the safety of the runners and spectators. The race director reserves the right to cancel the race if it is deemed unsafe for participants and volunteers. No refunds will be given.

❖ **Will there be water stops?**

Yes, there will be a water stop available midway along the course for the 5K and 2 water stops available on the 10K.

❖ **Is this a closed course?**

No, this is not a closed course. However, cones, course monitors, and Olathe Police will be along the entire route to protect runners and guide traffic accordingly. All residents along the course are notified in advance about potential closures and delays.

❖ **Are jogging strollers or roller skates/blades allowed on the course?**

No roller skates, roller blades, motorized vehicles, or any other wheeled transportation are allowed on the race course, with the exception of that used by police and officials who assist and monitor the course. Stroller are welcome but, encouraged to stay on the outer turns to prevent collisions with other participants.

❖ **Are pets allowed to on the course with me?**

Since this is not a closed course, for your safety and the safety of your pets, animals are not allowed on the course.

❖ **Will there be food and drinks at the finish line?**

Yes, a basic assortment of food and drinks will be provided at the finish line to help you refuel after the race.

❖ **Where can I find race results?**

During the race, official results will be posted plus computers will be available for individual print outs and results near the stage area. We will also post a link to results on our BUG RUN Facebook page and website.

❖ **What about race photos?**

We will have a selection of photos from race day posted to our BUG RUN Facebook page and website. A link will be available as well.
